WHY VISIT HUNGARY?

Hungary boasts Budapest, the "Pearl of the Danube", one of the most beautiful capital cities in the world, enjoying a superb panorama which is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Many travelers may ask the question "Why visit Budapest?", what is so special about it that one should include it in his/her travel plans.

Budapest is still an inexpensive city compared to other neighboring cities, with a wide variety of good-value for money accommodation. Budapest, a colorful experience, a little taste of Europe. The country has more than 1000 years of history and culture. The country is home to some outstanding historic towns and cities, numerous elegant castles, palaces and churches, as well as some attractive countryside. DESTINATION HIGHLIGHTS

Budapest is a fascinating and vibrant city, but there is plenty more to see in the countryside beyond. The most obvious tours are to the artists' colony in picturesque Szentendre and the famous Danube Bend, taking in the former religious centres of Esztergom and Visegrád to the North, all of which can be reached by boat. The small town of Gödöllő, just 30 km east of Budapest, is the site of Hungary's largest Baroque mansion and a great location for a concert and a picnic on the grounds. Budapest offers as a wide variety of cultural entertainment as well. There is always something going on in Budapest no matter in which season you come. There are great festivals all around the year (Budapest Spring Festival) and (Budapest Autumn Festival) are the two biggest cultural events.

There are more than 100 museums that welcome tourists with various exhibitions. The themes include fine arts, contemporary arts, science, history and gastronomy. The Budapest Opera House on Andrássy Avenue is not only cultural venue but also a beautiful architectural sight.





SHOPPING

Shops, boutiques, markets are plentiful in Budapest. The several shopping centers such as Arena Plaza, WestEnd City Center and Campona are great places to shop for designer clothes, electronics, books, jewelry, toiletries, small gifts, food stuff etc. As for buying authentic Hungarian gifts and local food ingredients (such as paprika powder, honey, Tokaji aszú wine, embroidery, among others) you can visit the Central Market Hall at the Pest end of the Szabadság híd (Liberty Bridge).

TASTY LOCAL FOOD

There are countless restaurants, inns, fast food places and international eateries in Budapest. There are streets and neighbourhoods that specialize in the restaurant and cafe business namely Liszt Ferenc Square and Ráday Street. Restaurants, cafes, pubs stand next to each other with outdoor terraces in the summer season.

WINTER HOLIDAYS

Unlike many other cities, Budapest does not sleep in winter. The season's highlight is Christmas with organ concerts, shops and streets decorated with Christmas lights. DAY 01, BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

DAY 05, VIENNA, AUSTRIA

After breakfast at the hotel, departure by bus to discover the highlights of Vienna, where we visit the Schönbrunn Palace, The Rococo Habsburg home with its impressive gardens. Then, proceed down the Ringstrasse, Vienna's tree-lined thoroughfare, viewing the Parliament building, The Vienna State Opera, the grand Hofburg Palace and finally the Habsburg's winter residence. Back to the hotel. Evening at leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 06, VIENNA, AUSTRIA

After breakfast, free day at leisure in Vienna for shopping. Overnight at the hotel.

• DAY 07, VIENNA- PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

After breakfast, drive through the pastoral landscapes of Bohemia on your way to Prague, one of Europe's most beautiful cities. Arrival Prague, check in and installation at the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 08. PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

After breakfast, a guided tour to discover "why Prague is known as the city of one hundred Spires". On the way to Salzburg, stop in the village of Cesky Krumlov to contemplate its UNESCO world heritage medieval quarter. Arrival Salzburg, check in and installation at the hotel. DAY 11, SALZBURG





DAY 01, PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

Arrival at Prague International Airport, universally called as the "Golden City" or "The City of 100 Spires" Meet and assist by our representatives at the exit door of the airport. Transfer to your hotel for check in and installation. The remainder of your day at leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 02, PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

After breakfast at the hotel, departure by motor coach for Prague discovery that includes a panoramic tour as we drive through the city, arrive at the amazing Hradcany Castle where you will stroll down the Golden Lane, then proceed to the beautiful St. Vitus Cathedral as well as the lovely statue-lined Charles Bridge. • DAY 06, VIENNA - DANUBE RIVER - MELK - VIENNA

After breakfast at the hotel, departure by motor coach to travel along the banks of the Danube to the Medieval Town of Durnstein where you board your boat for a scenic Danube River Cruise across one of the most breathtaking bodies of water in the world, immortalized by Strauss, and travel through the historic Wachau Valley. Afterwards, proceed to visit the 11th Century Melk Abbey, famous for its production and collection for manuscripts. A leisurely ride through the Vienna Woods concludes this marvelous day. In the evening, you will enjoy a memorable dining experience, including local entertainment, in the picturesque wine-making village of Grinzing and sample locally produced wine. Back to the hotel in Vienna and overnight.





DAY 07, VIENNA – BRATISLAVA, SLOVAKIA – BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

After breakfast at the hotel, departure by motor coach to Bratislava, former coronation city and Imperial capital of the Habsburg Empire, for a city tour with a local expert. Later in the day, head to Budapest, the "Queen of the Danube", truly one of the world's most beautiful cities. Upon arrival, visit the Matthias Church, site of many coronations of Kings. Visit the Fisherman's Bastion with its white walls, towers and arcades for spectacular views. Proceed to historic Old Buda and Gellért Hill, followed by the Parliament. At Heroes Square, admire the imposing Millennium Monument, completed in 1904, which memorializes the 1000th anniversary of Hungarian dominion. Back to the hotel and overnight.

DAY 08. BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

After breakfast at the hotel, departure on your own to explore the city of Budapest to enjoy the Hungarian cuisine while strolling the riverside streets of Majestic Budapest, or simply join an optional excursion to a countryside city called "Puszta" and visit a typical horse farm to learn the unique culture and history of the Csikós (Hungarian equestrians). You can even enjoy a thermal bath. Overnight at the hotel.

• DAY 09. BUDAPEST - SZENTENDRE - VISEGRÁD - BUDAPEST

After breakfast at the hotel, departure by motor coach to visit the beautiful baroque town of Szentendre and the former Renaissance capital of Visegrád for a magnificent view of the Danube bend and the Börzsöny Mountains. Proceed to visit the 14th century castle where knights with colorful costumes and authentic weaponry recreate the days of chivalry. After a short pause, enjoy a Gala Dinner to celebrate the tour at a special Renaissance-style dinner including wine and music at the castle restaurant and re-enact the medieval times. After dinner, back to the hotel for overnight.

DAY 10. BUDAPEST, HUNGARY







DAY 01, ROME, ITALY

Its gardens and fountains, and the wonderful Hall of Mirrors, a masterpiece of Versailles, was begun in 1678, when Versailles became the official residence. 17 windows overlooking the garden are related to the 17 arches decorated with mirrors, exceptional dimensions, made by the Parisian manufacture created by Colbert to compete with the Venetian products. It houses the largest collection of impressionist and post-impressionist masterpieces in the world, by painters including Monet, Manet, Degas, Renoir, Cézanne, Seurat, Sisley, Gauguin and Van Gogh. Many of these works were held at the Galerie Nationale du Jeu de Paume prior to the museum's opening in 1986. Back to the hotel after the tour and overnight in Paris.

Check out from the hotel after breakfast. Departure to Charles De Gaulle international airport for final departure flight back home.
